### Social Media Account Settings

Social media account settings involve a wide range of settings and options for different social media sites, including settings for account visibility, privacy, location, layout, notifications, and other preferences

Social media settings can shape your overall social media experience, including your privacy and security. These settings can control some of the following:

- Who can see what you post and share
- Who can find you on a social media platform
- Your location information

## Social Media Account Settings

Social media settings can shape your overall social media experience, including your privacy and security. These settings can control some of the following:

- Your name and picture
- Who can tag you in a photo
- What data is sent to places like advertisers
- Your login and security experience, including multi-factor authentication

#### **Best Practices for Social Media**

- Familiarize yourself with account settings
- Check your settings regularly
- Pay attention to updates or changes
- Look for best practices and recommendations online

#### Being Proactive and Mindful

Be mindful of what you post and share, and where you comment.

Your account settings can only do so much if you choose to disclose personal information or leave angry comments on posts. For instance, your account settings often do not stop people from viewing your replies and comments.

#### Discussion

What information have you seen posted online that might make someone vulnerable?

#### Consider your audience:

- If possible, set who can see your posts in your social media account settings
- Think about how you want to use a site. Is this information for friends and family or is this information you want to share with the general public?

Make sure you know what "public" means on each platform:

- Note that public can often mean that even people without an account on the platform can see your post
- Make sure you understand how these terms are being defined on the platform and what you are agreeing to with different settings

Manage your location settings:

- Be sure you aren't sharing location information
- Consider turning off the check-in feature

#### Control your comments:

- Think about how you want to receive comments
- Think about who you want to allow to comment on your posts
- Adjust your comment settings according to how much access you want to allow
- Identify options to delete or report comments that are abusive or harassing

Mute or block other users:

- Check your settings to see your options for controlling who follows you
- Remove or mute people who you no longer wish to engage with on the platform

Control how others tag you:

- Look for options to see if you can stop others from tagging you
- Look for settings that allow you to manually remove tags.

Be cautious with your personal information:

- Avoid sharing personal details that could lead to password hacks
- Consider what you share as well, such as information about your age or birthday

Manage your account security:

- Enable multi-factor authentication
- Manage your third-party apps and browser extensions
- Review the apps and services that have access to your social media accounts
- Remove apps and services liberally
- Avoiding grant third-party systems access to your account
